Another year of aspirations and achievements draws to a close and our school enters its thirty-fifth year. There has been a remarkable progress in all aspects. This year too, the results of Class X and XII held in March 2022 have once again brought laurels to our school by achieving a good result.

This year we received State level award **“Swatchh Vidyalaya Puraskar”** with an overall rating of 5 star from the Hon’ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Shri. Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy garu.

As per our tradition, The School Management introduced various extra-curricular activities in order to bring out the hidden talents of our students. This year, we have organized **“Ashramites Talent Meet”** to encourage and exhibit the individual talents of the students. We organized **“Think Room Day”** for Preprimary students.

Also, on the occasion of **“Ashramites Literary week”**, we have conducted various literary and Art & Craft competitions to all the students, to improve the standards of Communicative and creative skills.

To showcase our student’s academic activities, we conducted **“Ashramites Educational Fair”** in a grand manner. Hon’ble Sri Justice D. Seshadri Naidu was the chief guest. Students displayed their subject wise / class-wise projects / activities in more than 50 class rooms and Gym Hall.

As usual we celebrated Telugu Day in a very grand manner. Various literary activities were conducted and Prizes were given to the Winners. In the same manner, Teachers Day was also celebrated in a grand manner.

Teachers training programmes for all the staff members was organized in Online by CBSE on the various topics like Virtual Labs for Teaching learning, Learning Management System, Hybrid learning. Our School Principal Dr. T Augustine was appointed as CBSE City Coordinator for Puducherry and East Godavari districts by CBSE.

As per our tradition National Festivals were celebrated in a grand way. On 14<sup>th</sup> November 2023, Children’s Day was celebrated, where our kids participated in fancy Dress competition. International Yoga Day was celebrated in the Skating rink in the early hours where our students gave various yoga demonstrations.

To create awareness among the students about the importance of nature and its protection, we have taken our students of classes Play School to XII to **“field trips”** to various places like Maredimilli, Coringa wildlife -Sanctuary, Police Station, Archaeological Museum, Kadium Nurseries, Cotton Museum, Dowleswaram Barrage and Parks in Kakinada.

Many of our students have participated in various competitions conducted by different organizations & many of them have bagged prizes too.

In **SOF** competitions, in IGKO 22 of our students bagged gold medals, in IEO, Mr. P. Gagan Kumar of X-B got medal of distinction and 25 students bagged gold medals. In NSO, 35 students bagged gold medals and in IMO, Mr. Yashwanth Surya of XII bagged medal of distinction and 39 students bagged gold medals.

In **Rangotsav** National Level Competitions such as Coloring, Handwriting, Cartoon Making, Greeting Card Making, Collage, Photography, Finger and Thumb Painting 207 students bagged prizes. 10-Art Merit Awards, 16-Surprise gifts, 92- Gold medals, 47-Silver medals, 35-Bronze medals and all the 207 students are qualified for International Level Competitions.
